Introduction to Canada studies. In this course we will study about the peoples of Canada, and

then focus on specific events that happened Canada. Term 1: Introduction to Canada (Canadian

history basics, what groups of people immigrated to Canada, what attitudes did Canadians have

toward these new immigrants.); Term 2 - Specific events in Canadian history that can show us

about 'Canadian' people's attitudes to new immigrant groups.

Each week, students must research a specific topic from "the History of Canada". In class, we

will review the research, and then the teacher will give a brief lecture on a/some interesting points

from the class, and/or tell personal stories which relate to the theme. Students can ask the

teacher to explain any points in detail.

In the first term, students must do one small presentations, and there will be a review test at the

end of the term.

In the second term, students must do several small presentations, with a final report.

Requirements: a general interest in Canada. Willingness to participate in group work. Be

able to keep up with internet research (in English).
