#### \*授業概要 Outline of the contents

I would like to introduce you to various aspects of British culture and life, both modern and historical, from a native viewpoint. We will look at how Britain became a multicultural society; how society operates through its monarchy, the legal system, and religion; how people amuse themselves; what makes people feel "British"; and also look at what important events are in the news in Britain throughout the year.

#### \*授業の形式 How the class is conducted

The class will be conducted in English. Classes will be held on the Meieki campus. I will introduce certain topics (as listed above and on the website syllabus), and ask you to discuss them. You will be asked to prepare some topics about U.K. life that interest you, and present these to a small group in English during most weeks.

#### \*課題・成績評価基準 Requirements and Assessment

You will be asked to make a Power Point style presentation at the end of each semester about one of the topics that you used in your small-group presentations. You must also write two reports in English of 600-800 words each on two other topics related to the U.K. that you introduced in your small group presentations in classes. These are due in Week 12 and Week 15 in each semester. These must be your own work, not copy-pasted. All 6 topics over the year must be different. Your grade is based on class presentations at 20%; the final Power Point presentation at 30%; and 25% each for the two written reports.
