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\*ゼミタイトル Seminar Title The British Empire, and Britain after 1945

\*授業概要 Outline of the contents

In the first semester I will show how the British Empire began, then developed into the largest Empire that the world has ever seen, how it came to an end, and what legacy it has left in the world today. In the second semester we will look at post-1945 Britain, and how Britain has developed and changed after the loss of its empire and its entry into - and later exit from - the European Community. You will also be asked to prepare some topics about U.K. life that interest you (please see below).

\*授業の形式 How the class is conducted

The class will be conducted in English. Classes will be held on the Meieki campus. As in Year Three, you should prepare some U.K. related topics and introduce these in English to small groups during most classes.

\*課題・成績評価基準 Requirements and Assessment

There is a small change from last year. As before, you will be asked to make a Power Point style presentation at the end of each semester about one of the topics that you used in your small-group presentations. As for the written report, you must write two reports in English of 600-800 words each on two other topics related to the U.K. that you introduced in your small group presentations in classes. These are due in Week 12 and Week 15 in each semester. These must be your own work, not copy-pasted. All 6 topics over the year must be different. Your grade is based on class presentations at 20%; the final Power Point presentation at 30%; and 25% each for the two written reports.
